

## **2022 UMBHA YEAR END NOMINATION RULES**

## All nominations must be postmarked by 6/16/23

- Owner and Exhibitor must be a current member in good standing with IBHA and UMBHA to be eligible for UMBHA Year End awards for all IBHA classes and a member in good standing with UMBHA for All Breed Year End Awards (per the UMBHA bylaws; all show fees must be paid in full by 9/15/23 in order to qualify for year-end awards). Points will not be calculated until the current year membership is paid. Please include a copy of the current UMBHA membership card (Owner's & Exhibitor's) with the nomination form. Points will not be calculated until a copy of the card is provided.
- 2. Points will not be calculated until the nomination form is turned in. Nominations must be mailed with a postmark date of 6/16/23 or turned into the show office on Friday 6/16/23. No nominations will be accepted at the show starting on Saturday, 6/17/23. Checks must accompany nominations.
- 3. Nomination is on the horse in the IBHA Open, IBHA Ranch Horse, All Breed Ranch Horse & IBHA Miniature Horse Divisions. Horse/Rider combinations will be used in IBHA Youth, IBHA Youth 5-11, IBHA Amateur, IBHA Amateur Select and All Breed Select, Senior, Junior, Youth, & Tiny Tot Divisions.
- 4. In the case of a sale of a nominated horse to another UMBHA member during the show season, the year-end award earned will go with the horse and the owner on record at the time the award was won.
- 5. Points Calculation. Maximum points earned in a class are 6 per judge. Grand Champion Halter Horse will receive an additional 2 points and Reserve Champion Halter Horse will receive an additional 1 point.

- 6. It is the nominator's responsibility to be familiar with these rules. Please keep a copy of all nominations for your records.
- 7. The UMBHA Board of Directors will handle all disputes. All Decisions of the UMBHA Board will be final.
- 8. Please use a separate Nomination form per horse.
- 9. You must show under a minimum of 8 judges to qualify for year-end awards in each class. If you do not show in the before mentioned judges for each individual class, you will not be eligible for year-end awards in that class. Weanlings are and exception to this rule and they must show under a minimum of 4 judges to be eligible for year-end awards. In the case of the purchase of a new horse, said horse must be shown under all judges from the date of the purchase.
- 10. The following classes will count toward All Breed Division All Around titles: Western Trail and either Color Breed Halter; Solid Horse Halter or Pony Halter. (Only one halter class will count toward Year End and Weekend All Around titles).
- 11. Year End All Breed classes will include Saturday and Sunday Classes. The Sunday All Breed classes will be counted towards the All Breed Divisional year end awards using the same judges on Saturday and Sunday. Weekend Highpoint All Breed Awards will be awarded for Saturday classes only.
- 12. Nominations are for the individual classes and All Around division(s) of your choice. Please circle or highlight what you are nominating for. No substitutions will be allowed after the Nomination Form has been turned in.
- 13. All Classes in a division will count toward All Around divisions, you do not have to nominate in all classes for them to count for an All Around
- 14. Award certificates for 3<sup>rd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place in individual classes will be given out if they are requested by checking the box on the bottom of the nomination form.
- 15. Nomination fees are as follows: \$6.00 per class; \$15 per All Around Division. **Note:** The All Around Nominations are just for the All Around. This nomination does not include the individual classes.
