Proposed Rule Changes - Pleasure Speed

No changes proposed for speed.

- Pleasure- Once a decision is made for the horse/rider combination to move up to ANY 3 gaited classes at an approved WWHSA show, they will no longer be eligible for points in the W/T division that year. Horse/rider combination cannot cross enter from walk/trot into loping class.
- Clarification of rule #10- A horse may be entered only once per class. For classes that are judged on the exhibitor's performance (e.g showmanship, equitation, horsemanship), exhibitors may enter only one horse per class. In individual working events (e.g ranch riding, reining, western riding, trail), an exhibitor may show a maximum of three horses per class.
- Rules were voted on and passed.

Rule Changes Proposed Hunter/Dressage

- For Beginner Rider, Novice Rider in Hunter, and Intro Level in Dressage, if you win a Grand or Reserve Year End award two consecutive years, you are no longer eligible for the division.
- Hunter shows shall add a W/T/C benefit class. Riders in this class can have points going toward another division they are riding in. (ie: Children's or Adult or Open)
- Walk/Trot Equitation-riders who win a Grand or Reserve year end award in this division two consecutive years are no longer eligible to compete for WWHSA points in this division if they are 10 years or older.
- Rules changes were discussed, voted on and passed.

Covid 19 / masks

 Discussion on if WWHSA as an organization would mandate mask use at shows when not riding or allow clubs to decide mask requirement. Decision was made that clubs will be responsible for deciding if masks are required at show.
