 Ranch Horse classes **do not need to follow typical ranch horse standards (ie: no bands, no hoof black, no fake tails, no silver equipment) but will be judged to ranch horse class criteria. Cross entering allowed.
 *** Helmet's required in all 4-H Riding classes.
 ****W/T Division – horse & rider combination may **NOT** cross enter into any 3-gait classes
 ~Tack Changes must notify the office 2 classes PRIOR.
 ~Entries close 2 classes prior to the class entering.
 ~All judge's decisions are final.
 ~Judge or Show Chairperson may remove unruly or dangerous horses from the ring.
 ~Concession Stand available on grounds.

 Tiny Tot: 10 and Under
 Youth: 13 and Under
 Junior: 14 – 18
 Senior: 19 – 39
 Select: 40 and Over
 Walk/Trot Division: All ages

High Points in the following divisions – only division classes count toward high points: Tiny Tot, Youth, Junior, Senior, Select, Novice, Ranch Horse, Walk/Trot Division, 4-H.
All-Around High Point – includes all classes shown for the day. ^
 ^Must enter a halter class to qualify for All-Around.
