**Ranch Horse classes need to follow typical ranch horse standards (ie: no bands, no hoof black, no fake tails, no silver equipment) Cross entering allowed.

~Tack Changes must notify the office 2 classes PRIOR.

~Entries close 2 classes prior to the class entering.

~All judge's decisions are final.

~Judge or Show Chairperson may remove unruly or dangerous horses from the ring.

~Concessions on the ground

~ Junior horses (5&under) may be shown two handed in all classes with a bosal or snaffle.

Junior: 14 – 18

Senior: 19 – 39

Select: 40 & Over

Walk/Trot Divisions: 18 & Under
19 & Over

High Points in the following divisions; only division classes count toward high points:

Tiny Tot, Youth, Junior, Senior, Select, Novice, Ranch Horse, Walk/Trot Divisions
